The program promotes the creation of a young generation of perspective officials for state management, inter-governmental and non-governmental organizations, universities and thinktanks in Albania, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Croatia, FYR of Macedonia, Serbia, Montenegro and Kosovo, as well as in the countries belonging to the EU, the rest of Europe, and worldwide. ERMA is a one year interdisciplinary program consisting of three terms that combine the Balkans" and are supervised by academic studies with field research and working experience. In the second term, students participate in seven-week internships at selected IGOs, NGOs, think tanks and research institutes working in the field of human rights and democracy across South East Europe. During the third term, students focus on finalizing their Master's Theses in Italy, accommodated at the University of Bologna Residential Centre in Santa Sofia.

ERMA is open to candidates who hold a university degree in disciplines relevant to human rights, in particular law, politics, economics, sociology, journalism, psychology and humanities from an accredited university.
