Money Reimbursement:



- In Erasmus+ you will get 170 EUR per person for your travel costs according to distance calculator,
 except Portugal. Portugal has 400 EUR for each
- We can pay **only cheapest way of transfer** (economic class, not business class, not cars)
- Accommodation and food is granted 100% during whole project
- We will only reimburse your travel cost if you actively participate in the whole exchange!
- We also have budget for VISA costs for Poland and Portugal. Portugal has **25 EUR** for each participants and Poland has **15 EUR**

To be eligible for reimbursement, we ask you to keep all your tickets, boarding passes and receipts (originals). ONLY if you have the travel tickets, boarding passes and receipts we are able to reimburse your travel costs! We will also need your passport copies with the stamp that shows you entered the country. If you travel by your ID please keep the paper police stamped for you.





ORGANIZATIONAL STUFF

Please notify your teams about these things:

- You should notify us if you want to join or not in the shortest time
- You have to buy your tickets <u>before 20.10.2015</u>
- You should send us copy of tickets **till 20.10.2015**
- You have to prepare presentation of your country for cultural nights
- You should bring some documents about your NGO in order to present it
- Special needs (diets, medicine) tell us in advance, if you need any assistance from us in this matter, please
- DO NOT buy tickets until you get confirmation from us!



What to bring?:

- Towel, flip-flops
- Clothes for outdoor & indoor for duration of the exchange
- Medicines that you usually take
- **Passport** or other official identification
- Visa, invoices, boarding passes and travel tickets
- Travel insurance (optional, but highly recommended)
- Food and drinks from your country for cultural nights

YOUTH EXCHANGE IS...

educational exchange program dealing with non-formal education and informal learning, where young people from around the world live together in another country for some days, immerse themselves in the local community, and build bridges between cultures and countries. As these young people discover new worlds and make lasting friendships, they not only learn about main project topic, but also about another culture and a new language, they also gain perspective on the world and develop a stronger sense of self.

A Youth Exchange brings together groups of young people from two or more countries, providing them with an opportunity to meet, discuss, and confront various themes, while learning about each other's countries and cultures. The main aim is to encourage and promote the personal and social education of young people, reinforcing their feeling of being European citizens.

Youth Exchanges are intended to contribute to the personal development of the young participants. The exchanges are open to all European young people, regardless of their background, education, or socioeconomic situation.

YOUTHPASS

Every participant is individually entitled to receive a Youthpass Certificate which confirms participation and validates the non-formal learning (NFL) experience of Youth Exchange project. Validating the learning experience of participants is important in itself and the document can be of benefit in terms of the educational or employment future of the participant.
