Genesis at the Crossroads (www.gatc.org) is a nonprofit organization now in its 16th year that has been working at the nexus of human rights, education and the arts. It creates and implements innovative performance, educational and humanitarian programs worldwide and works towards a world where cross-cultural artistic expression and collaboration serve as a catalyst for inter-ethnic dialogue and innovation, global understanding and world peace.

In 2015, Genesis at the Crossroads launched the Genesis Academy Summer Institute for international students in Chicago. We are currently accepting applications from high school students ages 15-19 to participate in this 2-week program in Chicago for 2016. All travel expenses including room and board and medical insurance will be furnished by Genesis at the Crossroads along with Scholarship Sponsors, with the exception of any costs incurred for passport/visa fees and the requisite \$400 USD/student applicant fee.
